On the other hand, some of the passing exam scores are based on the knowledge and skills required to demonstrate competence in the subject and the complexity of the questions that are delivered to the candidate. The actual reduction score (the number of items that need to be answered correctly) is based on the input of a group of subject experts who consider the complexity of questions regarding the expected skills of the target audience. As a result, the number of subjects you need to answer correctly varies depending on the complexity of the questions asked during the exam. This ensures that no matter what combination of elements you see, the skill score is fair. If you see a more complex set of questions, the number of correct answers needed to pass is less than if you see a simpler set of questions. Because the number of correct answers needed to pass varies from the complexity of the questions posed, if you see a difficult mix of questions, your performance may actually be higher relative to the passing standard, even if you answered fewer questions in other words, a lower percentage) is correct than if you saw a simpler set of questions. However, the good news is that multiple options for questions are easier to answer than questions that await full, written answers, or even worse, essays!
